The Government of Nepal has received the FCPF grant from the World Bank toward the cost of Nepal REDD Readiness Preparation Program and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the following consulting service.

Technical Consultant for Financial Management

The purpose of this consulting service is to assess the existing financial management system and ensure that the overall financial management in REDD Cell strictly adhere to Government of Nepal and The World Bank's practices, guidelines and regulations. The consultant should work under the direct supervision of the chief of the REDD Cell while working in close collaboration with the Finance Officer in carrying out day-to-day financial management.

The individual consultant will be based at REDD Cell office in Kathmandu and will work for 10 working days per month for 10 months. The minimum qualification of Bachelor degree in professional accounting or Master degree in business administration or any other related fields and 5 years of general accounting experience including 3 years of specific experience in managing finances following The World Bank or Asian Development Bank or other major lending and development agencies is required. Preference will be given to those who have direct involvement in managing finances for The World Bank funded projects.

An individual consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 (Consultant Guidelines) adopting selection method of "Selection of Individual Consultants (IND)".
